July 4th Left home - 9:30 with Michael
Coffey & Airport - left at 12:30 - nice break
with wine & liquors. - unexpected headwinds - &
"pancakie descent" into Montreal airport, Montreal C
refused - (only took ~ 20 ms) - on to Toronto -
~ 1 hr + late. met by John guitars.
- supper at 6% (Toronto Inn) - bed at 9:30

July 5th Bacon & egg for breakfast after a reasonable
night. Roined so much indoors together
with Virginia & George Burns - left in
5% bus for Niagara Falls. Picked up by
conference van to Niagara Hotel in NSR.
Registered for conference & reception - film on
Niagara Falls. - enormous room w. 2 double beds

July 6th Conference Breakfast in hotel.

Lecture by glass. Peter charmed next session
lunch in small dive across road + walk
round Winter garden to conference centre.

Left conf. early for quick sleep. Walk across
to Goat Island to look at Canadian Falls. +
then had + Harry here to get ready for Bonnet.
Good meal - steak - with Sir Bauer. Bed late.

July 7th Breakfast + dinner. Lecture by Strelakas.

Lift up. early + went for walk to falls in hot
sunshine. Back for lunch at "The Place to Be" -
a church hall - lovely lunch with ecumenical hymns!!!
- signed visitor book. Refreshments in afternoon
Early + Harry King come in the evening - and
after a drink they took us out to Art Park
for picnic - chicken, fruit, cheese, wine etc
where we talked till it got dark and rather
nocturnally!! "fireflies". Went and looked in at
the theatre + had to sit in Winter Garden
until it closed.

July 8th Conference Peter gave our talk - very well received. Then off to Calypso trip. Bus wasn't air conditioned — it didn't work — so we were boiled!!!. Lunch at Calypso — look at appetites — very impressive — 0.4" thick SS dephrene — pressure breaking!! at 2000 atm (double dephrene — between at 1000 atm bled out & atmosphere) — also temperature gauges less than 1/8" in dia. — made of strip of pt ~ 4 times wide! (parted on). Back in over + to top of B Sunlet — Buffalo Univ. which we could all have done without! Quick wash at hotel + on to picnic at De Vaux rapids of Niagara River. Looked around Art gallery — lovely glass + windows — some nice paintings. Famous prime hot dogs, hamburgers, roast beef, corn on the cob — lots of salads, watermelon + apple pie + ice cream. Afterward entertainment of Broadway songs by high school children + Barber's song quartet. Sat + talked in Winter Garden later with Stellery's + Rae's.

Thurs. July 9th Not too much conference today?
very hot & humid Walked to American Falls
slowly and took back at "The Place to Be" and
watched the end of "Boyz up Baby".

Toronto esp thunderstorm with torrential rain
At end of conference Peter gave obituary for John Bradley.
After glass of wine & sandwich, took to Ontario & day
beside Falls — bus to Toronto & met by John & Jean
— stayed up talking.

July 10th Peter to York University but
didn't see Schiff but had reasonable day talking to
Tucker Carrington & Hasty. Jean & I went into
Toronto & looked round Eaton Centre — after which walked
up to University to pick up John — did washy-
in evening walk out to Dinees with the
Nyberg's & talked until after 12 about Keele.

Saturday - July 11th

Quiet morning -

reading, painting, talking, sleeping (Pete) then after lunch Sean took us to bus station to go to Rochester. (\$ca 22 net to Buffalo \$5.15 each to Rochester) lovely view of falls from Rainbow Bridge - good & well comfortable journey by Greyhound. Met at Rochester by Jack Williams - booked in at Key James Motel. Dinner at Williams - Roast Pork & Blueberry pie - very nice & lots of talk.. Bed etc

Sunday July 12th

No breakfast at motel -

walked along street acrossway to small "cafe" & nice breakfast - but no one walks this way usually. Walked up to the Williams house, and got a help yourself sandwich lunch we visited the Cornhill Festival - lots of stalls with art & handicrafts - watched a juggler - visited Helen's church & drank beer - very hot & lots of people. Back to Williams house to read newspapers & we all had a sleep. Chinese meal this evening - then Peter - I tried out the tennis machine - one could soon learn that way. Walk and houses, more talk then back to Mill relatively early.

Monday 13th July up at 7, breakfast at motel, then collected by Jack at 8 for day at Kodak. Exhausting day - visits to various labs, Peter gave his talk, nice talk at Int'l Staff Club - more birds - we came very early at 4:45 after a very full day. Jack took us to the bus station & we ate sandwiches on the bus. Swift & a friend travelled James Cook to Toronto, only interrupted by Canadian customs at the Peace Bridge. Next at bus station by Milwaukee & Barry & back to Barry's house for the night.

Tuesday 14th July Milwaukee brought in tea in bed! In the morning together with 2 small boys, we visited Ontario Place - saw the movie " " on large 40' x 60' screen, made me feel quite sick - then on to the paddle boats, fun but hard work. Sandwich lunch - then watched children playing in swimming in water play area - the Village. Left at 1 and Barry took us to airport. A good time for plane to Winnipeg; Peter met Keith in the Gents!! swift journey to Pinawa (~70 miles) - lots of talk over dinner together with children Anna (13) Andrew & Paul,

saw small skunk in neighbour's garage

Wednesday 15 July up late - Keith came back for Peter
who was off to the plant to give talk + see people
After copies for books - brief walk to store -
back to visit Andrew, Paul, swing - met
Pat + Alan + 2 girls - who also stayed to dinner and
the night - Austin + Estelle came later - lots of talk
- stayed up till about 11 pm Oh Hell!

16 July Alice took Peter + I to the plant for a visit -
very interesting to see top of Nuclear reactor. Met Keith
who took us down to see
Also saw Keith's Analyzer. Back to Pinawa for
lunch - borrowed Austin's canoe + set off down dam
+ along cut of Winnipeg River - several rapids -
long stretches of marshes - lots of birds - sunrose -
carried canoe over waterfall but got caught in rocks
at next rapids + canoe 'filled' with water - Keith pushed
off + we went over the rest backwards. Got to Old
Pinawa - previous hydro electric scheme - carried canoe
out - but realised we were late + had only gone $\frac{1}{2}$ way
(8 miles) - so walked off to phone - but got lift to
Alice + home again to pick up canoe

Evening eating - Barbecued steak etc at Austin & Estevan. - lovely evening - too much to eat + drink - Pete played table-tennis, I talked to Austin - bed-gear + 1 o'clock. - saw partial eclipse of moon.

Friday July 17 up late - with Alice + children to Grand Beach ~ 90 miles - in shore of Lake Winnipeg lovely afternoon ~~swimming~~ swimming in warm water - sunbathing, eating etc - back for pyjamas for supper and bed early (~ 11)

Saturday 18 Left at 10 to drive to Morris to visit the Stampede (2nd largest in Canada) - lots of people - quick look of hamburgers - then to arena for bucking broncos, steer wrestling, steer catching + ball riding - all very impressive - stunt riding (1 lady hurt - but taken to hospital - OK) Afterwards looked at horses, cattle, bulls, heavy horse carriages, trotting ponies etc. Then after drinks in the Crystal City to visit Alice's Aunt + Uncle Hart + Eleanor - they were charming - lovely supper, then out to wiener bake (hot dogs) at Lake Laggan (about 15 miles!!) - not more relations - finally home again late (bed ~1)

Sunday 19th July Up early & off to visit more
of Alice's relatives - at Boissevain - The Howards
who each year have large family picnic - we
had had a lovely picnic lunch in the garden -
met lots more relatives, then left about 1 for the
drive to Winnipeg airport (~170 miles)

Our trip to Manitoba has been fantastic and we
felt quite sorry to leave - long straight open roads
(all at right angles) across vast fields of alfalfa, flax
etc., & through the forests of the east. Penaiwa
is at the end of the road. Keith is busy
building extension to his house - the outside was
finished by the contractor - he is doing the inside
- we slept upstairs - no doors, washbasin not yet
installed - but we did have walls & lights -
Alice & Keith's bedroom downstairs - didn't yet have
walls!

Lift Winnipeg airport for Albuquerque via Denver.
- fantastically flight from Denver over mountains with
lightning flashing in the east.

Put up in Visitors Officers Quarters VQF in Kartchner
Airbase - in Suite "The Altars" a large
room connecting toilet + shower to a bedroom.
Phil Whitefield picked us up at airport + stayed
till for a bit afterwards.

Monday 20th July Breakfast at Officers Mess. -
Phil picked us up at 8.45 - Peter gave his talk
first - then visits + various people until ~ 4 o'clock
- very hot outside (101 F) Phil took us to post office
- then we were back and visited. Out to dinner
a Mexican Restaurant with Phil + Anne Marie -
hot - but very nice - Then walk round old town
and finally sat outside little cafe eating ice cream +
dark coffee at 11 o'clock.

Tuesday 21st July Phil picked us up again for
a visit round his lab and to see the 'O₂' generator
- 18" dia tube x 72' - 90% H₂O₂ + KOH +
Cl₂ bubbled in - purifies system and enormous
purges + safety systems for Cl₂ + H₂O₂ etc
- also saw work on I₂/F₂ laser - so safety
systems for F₂ too.

Out to lunch at governan sandwich Bar with Phil —
then our tour was over. After a rest - we caught
the shuttle bus to National Atomic Museum -
well laid out & interesting - then we walked the
miles back - temp 102 F!!! (a record)

Went out to visit Mike & Rocky Reddy - lovely
meal - lots of talk of our tour & Keele, & Phil's job.
One late - again —

Wednesday July 22nd Hired car (Huffy) for our
holiday to the north - visited Atom Museum again
as we did here much the there yesterday - then
off shopped at Bonadilla then on up towards
^{Pueblo} Jemez Springs - ate lunch in car - too hot
outside - dark surroundings. On up into
Bitter Santa Fe forest - walked road & looked at
Soda Dam at Jemez Springs. — On to Los
Alamos. — first room at Hilltop House Motel (27.50)
& after short rest - into Santa Fe to get tickets for
Opera - in town - Dinner in The Bullring
(musician again) then walked road old town
Plaza. - Governor's Palace, church of San Miguel

Out to Opera - held in basin in the hills - we
 saw Paphne by Richard Strauss - it was
 beautiful, and still warm at 11 Book &
 his Almanac

Thursday 23rd July Visited Scenic Musuem
 - not so good as one at Kristian - but lots of
 pictures - then on to Bandelier National
 Monument - a park near here which has ruins of
 Indian Pueblo settlers ~ 1300 - After lunch
 we walked to Ceremonial Cave ^{~1 mile} + climbed 140' to
 reach it by a succession of ladders! Back on
 other side of Frogole's Canyon to see ruins -
 hot + thirsty. Left ~ 3 and drove via
 Espanola, Chimayo + Penasco (76)

to Taos. - first time staying in
 Sun God Motel just outside built in typical
 adobe style - in Taos + looked round
 Plaza + to eat dinner overlooking plaza.
 Very tired + didn't sleep well.

Friday 24th July Breakfast at Mac Donalds. Then on to Taos Pueblo - primitive village Indian life wareheded round + round church, crafts + bread baking - on by 64 - to Rio Grande Gorge Bridge 650 ft above river. Lunch at camp ground by Hopewell Lake - short walk $\frac{1}{2}$ very round - saw hummingbird around trees. Stopped at Chama to look at Railway + photograph engines. On to Pagosa Springs where we spent the night at the Spa Hotel - I did the washing then we went swimming in the outside pool - fed by water from the springs - so it was warm ($\sim 95^{\circ}\text{F}$ I guess). After that dinner I had a trip to the bath house to immerse myself in the spring waters at 105°F - very hot + wavy. Bed early - 10

Saturday 25th A dip in the bath, then a swim in the pool before breakfast.

Drove north on 160 (Road Works at Wolf Creek Pass) then onto 149 at South Fork. Lunched at Spring Creek Pass on the Continental Divide - and for a walk (10898 ft)

saw corner of Grossbill. On to Gunnison
then we took the 135 to Coated Butte +
on over the Kebler Pass on ~40 miles of
unmade road !!! on to ~~Penn~~ Paonia for
the night. Fantastic Scenery all day

saw lots of chipmunks + such large animals
I saw sparrowhawk

Sunday 26th July 411 miles

Breakfast in our motel then on again - more
fantastic scenery stopped at Glenwood Springs
for coffee and shopping. On to Baggs in
torrential rain - bush in car and then
into Wyoming - - just long roads and
undulating country - saw herd of bison +
several groups of deer. Helped broken down
car bus by sandy & recovery truck from next
garage. Dinned (truck) in Rock Springs -
Chinese + very nice - then phoned motel in
Forson + stayed there for the night - only
motel for >100 miles!

Monday 27th July Drove north - planted
by Shoshone Mts into Jackson where we stopped
for coffee, & shopping & gas. Then on into the
Grand Teton Park - after early cloud in the hills -
the sun was shining. Hiked back at the
side of Pilgrim Creek off the beaten track
an idyllic setting. Then on to Yellowstone -
no accomm so we were forced on inn in
W Yellowstone just outside the park.
Walked road geyser at West Thumb - then on
to see Old Faithful and walked round some
of the geysers there. Nice dinner I had in
the cafeteria + then home - looking at all
odd thermal activity enroute. Our room
is in an inn but of comfortable.

Tuesday 28th July Drove into the Park to
Canyon Village for coffee, then round
the north rim of the canyon + down foot-path
& look at falls. Lunched just off road near
Mr Washburn - saw deer (elk) who watched
us unconcernedly. Walked round rim of forest

Then climbed Mt Washburn from Dunraven Picnic Area (10243 ft) A nicely graded track all the 3 miles to the summit (it seemed longer though) but at the altitude one quickly gets out of breath - sunny all the way but quite windy on top - saw lots of Mountain blue birds. Lovely walk but we are both quite tired - Dined in cafeteria at Canyon Village. Then we went on a drive to see the mud Volcanos - Sulphur Cauldron - all yellow with particles of S and a lot of f. & - fantastic.

So when we finally drove home it was dark - saw an owl-hued carpet and all the ranger.

Wednesday 29th July Put the alarm on to 3.45 and sat up in bed watching the Royal Wedding until 5.30 - then we went back to sleep - the pictures were very good & I'm pleased we woke up. Explored the Norris Geyser Basin both before & after lunch in the trees watched En erupt.

then after 30 min sleep in the car we explored the Lower Geyser Basin, Fountain Paint Pots + the Sulfur Basin - all very sparse → not just another geyser!! ~~Kash~~ Dinned at Old Faithful Cafeteria - watched the eruption + a film of geysers!! Then home & bed relatively early (~10)

Thursday 30th July up early (~7) +

drove to Salt Lake City (410 miles)

Slow through Yellowstone - Breakfast at Old Faithful + saw it erupt - then photographed Moose just before the exit. Drove down thru Grand Tetons via Jenny Lake, stopped at Jackson + then on quick lunch in the car - Tea + a swim at Bear Lake - Dinner at Brigham City - Jord Lk City Motel v. nice.

Total 2044 miles

Friday 31st July Breakfast in room, then Eds took car back - plus it - suppose as it cost us - \$300 + there was no day-off charge.

walked to Temple Square + round 2 roaster centers - coffee then bus back to motel + a quick swim before being picked up by Brzkenridge - lunch at top of Union Building overlooking city. After brief talk by Br. the Pts gave his talk - more discussion - walked back to motel ~ 5 - another swim - v. hot. Out + dinner at Village Inn opposite - then bus to town + concert in Tabernacle with Mormon Youth Chorus - nice sound but too bland - walked round Planetarium after, last bus home + another swim!

Saturday 1st Aug up early - breakfast at Village Inn + taxi to airport. Swift + Westinghouse trip to airport - over Las Vegas. - Then after some indecision - rented car from Budget - got larger car than we ordered but it lower price - very smuggy - 2 bbs!

Drove out until the traffic along Pacific Coast Highway + round Redondo Beach -

found small + perhaps dubious motel within walking distance of beach - so walked down + down to Redondo Pier where we had hamburgers outside for a late lunch. Walked round the rest of the shops + restaurants etc back to motel for sleep. Down to the beach again for a quick swim - I didn't go out past the huge breakers but enjoyed it in the surf - Peter swam for yes.

Showers on the beach - the beach + motel + in to Pier for dinner - both had fish very nice

Sunday Aug. 2nd off to Disneyland

Arrived at ~ 10:30 + stayed until 9:30 pm!! We both enjoyed it enormously. - Went on lots of rides but only the 1st was really of the two scary kind - but we both found it exhilarating + would have tried again (perhaps) - the pirates were outstanding - had two good meals eat too. + Finally watched lighted procession + fireworks - Home ~ 1 hr exactly.

Monday Aug 3rd

Took off for breakfast to do the washng - Then
fl to Aerospace at El Segundo for 11 o'clock Talk
with Rick Heidner - lunch across road where we needed
security clearance - more talk then Peters Talk

left ~ 4th clock - back to motel + down to beach for a swim. To Healdsburg for dinner (Cornwall Inn - dinner with Zellner + Mrs Witty. home late - 12.30.

Tuesday 4th Aug. Drive to SF - traffic jam outside Santa Barbara - took centre road back + tea on beach but - arrived to SF just before (10) + very tired. 410 miles.

Wednesday 5th Aug. Peter went to visit Zaire's group and I spent the morning lazily - went up Hood Tower, looked in church + bookshops - met Peter + Zane for lunch - buffet + very nice - then back for talk about synchrotron radiation + a visit to the Linen Accd. - finished about 4.30 + went back to our room + slept. Left after this + drove into SF - left the car at the BART station at Daly City + went the rest of the way by train - walked round a bit + got a bit lost, then found a Hertz office + nap + visited Chinatown (cold + foggy!!!)

Had a wonderful ~~week~~ dinner with Mr. Kans -
then home - arriving back ~ 12:30.

Thursday 6th Aug

both feels tired + indecisive.

drove into SF + visited the Golden Gate Park
had lunch at opposite Seal Rocks.
looked at seagull + pelicans through the
binoculars. To Airport - left car
very smoothly - good trip with dinner in
Seattle. Seymour Rabindranath met us
+ took us though the city to his house overlooking
Washington Lake. - sat out on veranda + ate
strawberry shortcake + tea - talky with Seymour +
Flora. Fotoulous house - collection of glass,
Staffordshire blue ware, quilts etc.

Friday 7th Aug

Homemade muffins + blueberries on
veranda for breakfast - Then trips round
Arboritorium, Japanese Garden + Expressway
Park in centre of Seattle - collected another
v. small - car.

quick look at Student Union, then visit to Chem lab - While Peter was giving last talk I visited a museum & art gallery. Back to Sigma's house & pick up Peter's jacket - then we left. After dinner, drove to North Bend for the night - hot.

Saturday 8th Aug

Continued along 9 all day via Ritzville & Spokane & stopped early at Coeur d'Alene - at Sandman Motel after own in lake - v. hot - at 1-2 probably in 100's - still 90 by 60% & fairly much water - saw many small sand storms. ~ 280 miles

Sunday 9th Aug

Drove north on 95 & over border into Canada after walking & fishing cords in USA hot funnel in lake Mayie after a quick swim - saw water snake. Stopped early at Windermere & swam in the lake. Dinner at Radium & phoned Colin - looked like possibility of hiring boats, no go!

Monday Aug 10th Dicl washing before leaving. 24

Drove to Radium Hot springs + went for swim in hot pool, followed by swim in cool pool. Lunch there then on to Lake Louise — all looked up so back to Banff + found cool basement where we both slept off head aches. After dinner walk round town + souvenir shops + drove up to hot springs.

Tuesday Aug 11th

Up late + cooked our own breakfast. Then off to Mt Norquay + a walk up to the Amphitheatre in Cascade Mt. long hot walk up through pine woods (~ 4 miles 2000 ft) - very b. beautiful, the large bowl in mountains - saw bear footprint - long walk but quite tired in the end - bed early. hot

although v. tired - didn't sleep well though we shut off the train by shutting the windows!

Wednesday Aug 12th

Looked breakfast - then drove north
amid prettier scenery - turned by North
Saskatchewan River - fly infected - not too clean
- very fast flowing river. On to Athabasca
glacier. We walked to the toe & took pictures -
then drove up the side & climbed over the
moraine to overlook glacier and see another - steep
scrubbed back. Drove swiftly home with a
look at Lake Louise en route - slept badly - I
was disturbed by my ~~lippie~~ insect bites.

Thursday Aug 13th up late - then to Banff
to do some shopping - so we had lunch at
Coral Creek picnic area - absolutely delightful -
shady little, rushing stream, very few people &
several marmots to watch & photograph.

Then on to Lake Louise - a walk despite my already
aching legs. We climbed up to the tea house
at Lake Agnes where we drank large quantities
of tea, then rode the like and up again to
the Beehive & the Sir Lookout.

Down lake Louise side & along to the Plain of
the Six Glaciers & over tea at another tea
house that we reached at 6:30 just as it was
ready to close - then a brisk walk back lit
4 miles to the end of the lake - a superb walk
~ 12 miles - ~ 1600 ft - so we really were quite
tired - saw several deer, an elk and a
young male moose that walked suddenly across the
road in front of our car. - slept very well -
(no coffee at dinner) after a hot bath.

Friday Aug 14th Opened my practice &
we delighted. - the binoculars, beautiful Nadeau
meekness of solvers, totoquaine & little jahle leaping
- as well as Judge! Breakfast ate, then
packed up to go & phoned Mike - got
through to him easily at DV office, learnt his good
results - he was delighted! what it was lovely to
talk to him for a few minutes (6 mins - \$15)

Stopped en route at Moraine Lake & scurried
along the banks, then on - the Trans
Canada Highway - very crowded & very hot

not too pleasant driving - looked at some
trams on railway. Drove to Vernon &
stopped at small "motel" - Sunn Village
by road, but we had a lovely swim in
the lake.

Saturday Aug 15th

Got up & had another superb long swim in
the lake - watched a small heron on the bank
body orange color beneath, crown on top & tip of tail
black. Then drove on to Kelowna where
we hadрова breakfast & did shopping.

Stopped at Penticton & hired a motor boat
(speed boat) bought red with 90 hp. Evinrude motor
- we only got up to 35 mph! - spent an hour
driving round the lake - then picked up Jeremy
& Peter did some water skiing - got up for
short time in first go, after hitting several trees -
had more long runs - out about another hour!
very hot but lovely

Lunch late at Summerland. - Then on to
Manning Prov. Park where we swam again

in Lightning Lake. Stopped the night there at the Lodge + had dinner at the coffee shop.

Sunday Aug 16th Left garage this morning

we didn't swim! cut hair instead!!

Breakfast in Hope after long run down from 4400' to ~ 300' (road works as well)

Drove down to border with US at Sumas + packed our last cords. - back up to T at Mission + had bush by side of road in tiny shack (much cooler near the sea) - Then on to Vancouver and the university - great crush at the reception - we have 2 free rooms on 8th floor just the wash facilities or rather unusual.

Took the car on a loop round the Marine Drive - (large rafts of logs moored near the shore) then into downtown and went Stanley Park

Dropped the car off and walked to Chinatown where we had a superb meal including coffee for \$15! Pay Fee. Then on to the reception at Hotel Vancouver + bus back to campus.

Monday 17th Aug

Conference

Huge opening meeting in gym. - Lecture by Eigen off & various other meetings off in different places. (3 diff buildings & lots of diff rooms) Lunch at graduate club, more conference & we put up our posters ready for Thursday. None for a rest then a social at the delicatessen bar downstairs and a walk round cayman and down to the beach. Lots of huge logs washed up - found we had walked to Wreck beach for the midists - luckily it was late so not many about!! Drink and bed early.

Tuesday 18th

More conference after Breakfast in Don Romay's Took the off afternoon to visit the Museum of Anthropology - superb - with lots of skeletons. Back to conference - we back to Museum to take photos. Wash & dry the car & wine reception at graduate club -

warn for bus to town & harbour in
McDonalds - then on to next bus to
Tom Bell's for the evening. - met people
from Australia and from St. John's.
Lucky salmon supper. got left back
with Jones!!.
